Carbon Monoxide (CO) Alarms

- **Carbon Monoxide (CO) is odorless, tasteless, and invisible.** It can cause illness and, at high enough levels it can be deadly.
- Dangerous levels of Carbon Monoxide can accumulate inside of your home, cabin, or camper if Carbon Monoxide producing appliances or equipment are not working properly, are not properly vented, or are used improperly.
- Sources of Carbon Monoxide can include stoves, fireplaces, water heater, furnace, dryer, grill, lawnmower, snow-blower, generator, cars, trucks, and motorcycles. Never operate any of these appliances or equipment without proper and adequate ventilation.
- UL listed electric Carbon Monoxide alarms with digital displays and battery back-up are recommended for installation inside of your home, cabin, or camper. Install one alarm on every level and one outside every sleeping area.
- Test each alarm at least 1x a month. Replace when they expire (date on alarm) or show an end of life indicator.
- Do you know the difference between the alarm and the low battery sound?
BEEP BEEP BEEP BEEP BEEP... (ongoing) is the Alarm. Leave and call 9-1-1.
BEEP (30 seconds of no sound) **BEEP** (30 seconds of no sound)... check your battery.
Not sure which it is? Leave your residence and call 9-1-1!
